Upgrade Procedure for SAM-Q-SDI

The latest SAM-Q-SDI software release can be download from <a href="https://www.tslproducts.com/product-support/audio-products-support-suppor

Place the SAM-Q-SDI software into the root of a USB thumb drive.

Upgrading from SAM-Q-SDI v1.0x to SAM-Q-SDI v2.0x or later.

If you are upgrading from v1.0x to v 2.0x or later, please follow these steps.

If you are upgrading from v2.0x to a later version, please go straight to 'Upgrading from SAM-Q-SDI v2.0x' later in this document.

TSL recommends that you take a note of your system configuration before updating from 1.0x to 2.0x or later as your configuration will be lost in Step 2 below.

1. Power up the SAM-Q-SDI whilst holding in the F1 button until you see the following display.



- 2. Select Erase System
- 3. Insert the USB thumb drive into the front panel of the SAM-Q
- 4. Select the 'Update from USB' option.
- 5. Wait until the software update has completed.
- 6. When complete, the SAM-Q will return to normal operation.
- 7. Remove the USB thumb drive.



Upgrading from SAM-Q-SDI v2.0x

If you are upgrading from v2.0x please follow these steps

- 1. Push and Hold the F1 Function button for 1 second.
- 2. Navigate to User Menu/System Setup/Advanced Setup/Restart System and select 'Restart the box'
- 3. Push and Hold the F1 button whilst the SAM-Q-SDI restarts until you see the following display.



- 4. Insert the USB thumb drive into the front panel of the SAM-Q
- 5. Select the 'Update from USB' option.
- 6. Wait until the software update has completed.
- 7. When complete, the SAM-Q will return to normal operation.
- 8. Remove the USB thumb drive.
